### Key outcomes

- 100% of participants thought the workshop *achieved what they expected*.
- 100% of the participants thought the workshop was pitched at the right level.
- 100% of participants reported the facilitator's attitude was *very good to great*.
- 100% of participants reported the facilitator's knowledge of the subject was *very good to great*.
- 100% of participants reported the way the course was run was *very good to great*
- 67% of participants who completed evaluations reported the handouts were very useful

**Has the training program covered what you expected? If partly or no, why?**

**What topic/issue has been the most important for you?**

- Exercises.
- What does presence look like?
- Feedback on exercise.

- Characteristics of group leadership presence (don't need to be 'charismatic').
- Although it was uncomfortable and I felt anxious, the experiential exercises were most beneficial.

- Practical delivery.
- Purpose for our leadership is to help group members be more effective as parents/people.
- The presence of a group leader, how this has evolved for me – just be myself and take more risks with ease.
- I like to have opportunity to practice in front of peers.

**What topic/ issue has been the least important for you?**

- Can't think of anything. It has all been good.
- Initially thought the storytelling – but actually was useful by the end of session.
- Meaning attributions – because I didn't quite understand it.
- None.
- First exercise.

**What impact will this training have on your work?**

- I had the opportunity to facilitate with someone I don't normally facilitate with. It was fantastic to see other ways of groupwork.
- Very good.
- Reflection on role, thinking about context and how I can integrate skills/strats for the groups I run.
- More experiential exercises.
- Presence – balance characteristics better.
- Lots of reflections and considerations for next group.
- Increased confidence in my presence in teams/groups – leadership addition.
- Adventurous and try new things.
- Using more tools and passing more of it over to the participants.
- Start where group is at, add to it, and pick it up and amplify it.
- Make me more confident especially working in front of my peers – be myself.
